Recipe - muffins

In the storybook Rex helps bake muffins. He tries hard but he's not a very good cook. Here's the recipe so that you can help in the kitchen too (remember to check with Mum or Dad before you start cooking). Are you a better cook than Rex?

What you need:

- 2 cups plain flour
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 2 ripe bananas, mashed
- 3 tablespoons honey
- 3 tablespoons vegetable oil I large egg
- $\frac{3}{4}$ cup milk

What you need to do:

- · Mix the flour, baking powder and banana together in a large bowl.
- In a different bowl mix honey, oil, egg and milk together.
- · Pour the wet ingredients into the bowl with the banana.
- Mix together.
- Spoon the mixture into a greased 8-hole muffin tin or patty papers.
- Place into oven and cook for 20 minutes at 180 degrees celsius.
- Let the muffins cool and enjoy!

Sock puppet Rex

What you need:

- I old white sock
- Craft glue
- Scissors (ask Mum or Dad first)
- 3 black or brown buttons (nose and eyes)
- A pen or marker
- Scraps of brown fabric for the ears and eye-spots (the dark patches around Rex's eyes)
- · Small scrap of red fabric or felt for the tongue.



Put the sock on your hand so that your thumb is in the heel and your fingers are in the toe.



Make the puppet talk and mark with a pen where its eyes, tongue, nose and ears should be.



me-OOW

Cut 2 small circles out of the brown fabric to make the eye-spots. Use the craft glue to glue the eye-spots in place. Then, glue on the eyes and the nose.



Using the brown fabric, cut out 2 floppy ears and stick them onto the head of your Rex puppet.





Using the red fabric, cut out a tongue and stick it on for Rex's mouth.



If you don't have any red fabric, you could use a red marker to draw a tongue.

Now you have your very own Rex! You can practice making a WOOF and a GRRRRR. You can help tell Rex's story, or even make up your own adventure for Rex.



First, colour in the picture frame using your favourite colours. Then, carefully tear the frame out of the Activity Book.

Find a photo of yourself, a friend, your family, or even your pet. Stick the photo behind the frame with some sticky tape.

If you don't have a photo you could always draw a picture of Rex instead (instructions on page **I**).
